## WHO THE QUALIFICATION IS FOR?

This qualification would be appropriate to anyone aged 16 and above and will enable the learner to develop the knowledge and skills needed when supporting teaching and learning in the school environment.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants should have achieved GCSE grades A\*-D, show enthusiasm for this sector and have excellent communication skills.

Acceptance onto the programme will be subject to successfully completing an initial assessment and interview.

Applicants will also be required to undergo a Criminal Records Bureau check.

## WORK PLACEMENT / EMPLOYMENT

We will help you secure a suitable position with a local school that will support you throughout your apprenticeship. As a minimum, you will receive a wage of £2.50 per hour.

## ASSESSMENT

Assessment will be carried out in different ways, gathering knowledge from direct observation of practice, witness evidence from the employer, professional discussion, written assignments and tasks set by CACHE for knowledge learning outcomes.

## PROGRESSION

Candidates who complete this qualification can progress onto an Advanced Apprenticeship, Level 3 Diploma in Specialist Support for Teaching and Learning in Schools (QCF)
