

TEACHING ASSISTANT

WHO THE QUALIFICATION IS FOR?

This qualification would be appropriate to anyone aged 19+ who would like to work with teachers in a classroom supporting the learning process in primary, special and secondary schools. You may have a range of job titles such as teaching assistant and will work under the direction of the class teacher.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Ideally applicants should have A – C grades in Maths and English although these grades are not an essential. Applicants will also be required to under go a Criminal Records Bureau check.

WORK PLACEMENT / EMPLOYMENT

You should already be employed in this environment or working in a voluntary capacity.

ASSESSMENT

This will be through a combination of observation of performance, evidence collected in the workplace, assignments and projects.

PROGRESSION

Candidates who complete this qualification can progress onto a Level 3 NVQ for Supporting Teaching and Learning In Schools

FUNDING

Funding may be available depending on eligibility and the candidates previous qualifications.

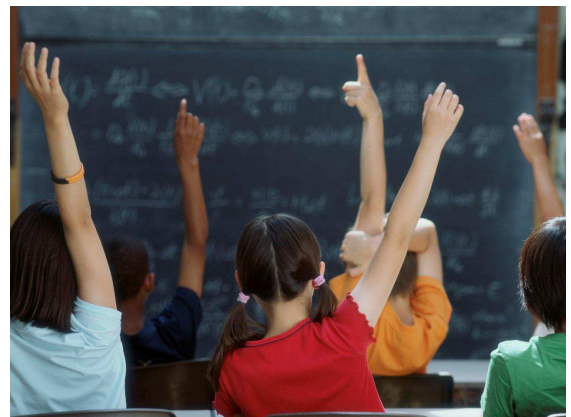
