

TEACHING ASSISTANT

WHO THE QUALIFICATION IS FOR?

This qualification would be appropriate to anyone aged 19+ who work with teachers in a classroom supporting the learning process in primary, special and secondary schools. You may have a range of job titles such as teaching assistant and will work under the direction of the class teacher who has the overall responsibility for teaching and learning.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Ideally applicants should have A – C grades in Maths and English although these grades are not an essential. You will also need to have completed supporting teaching and learning in schools level 2 Applicants will also be required to under go a Criminal Records Bureau check.

WORK PLACEMENT / EMPLOYMENT

You should already be employed in this environment or working in a voluntary capacity.

ASSESSMENT

This will be through a combination of observation of performance, evidence collected in the workplace, assignments and projects.

PROGRESSION

Candidates who complete this qualification can progress onto a Level 4 NVQ for Supporting Teaching and Learning In Schools.

FUNDING

Funding may be available depending on eligibility and the candidate's previous qualifications.
